Apply!

- For admission: complete an application: www.hfcc.edu/apply
- **Provide HANK ID and Hawkmail Address to coach upon receipt**
- For financial aid: complete the FAFSA: www.hfcc.edu/finaid by June 1st
- To be protected for classes: Submit Additional financial aid documentation by June 22nd

Attend Orientation!

- Schedule and attend orientation session at www.hfcc.edu/orientation by July 15th
- Participate in Course Placement (Compass Test) by June 22nd. If you have ACT scores, take them with you to the Course Placement testing area.
