

At the conclusion of the Great Lakes Wrestling Championship there will be an awards ceremony.

Tournament Officials

The tournament officials will be assigned by the MCCA Association Director of Officials for wrestling and they will be paid \$10 more per game than the rate established by the governing MCCA association.

Bench Area/Passes/Floor Credentials

Each team will be issued official lanyard passes or a badge at the time of team check-in. The lanyard passes or badges will need to be worn when the tournament is in session.

Tournament Program

A tournament program will be available for participants and guests to purchase. Please make sure your current roster and team picture is sent to Al Perry at al.perry@mcc.edu by February 12th.

Sports Information/Media and Credentials

Photographers and a media team will be in attendance.

Website

Tournament will be on Track Wrestling and the NJCAA Region XII website.

Concessions

The Ballenger Fieldhouse concession stand will be open throughout the course of the tournament.

Facility Diagram

A facility diagram will be available at check-in.

Transportation/Travel Information

All transportation arrangements will be the responsibility of the participating team.

Laundry Facilities

On-site laundry at the Ballenger Fieldhouse is available for game gear, make arrangements with the tournament director if your team wishes to have items washed.

Hospitality Room

During the tournament, a hospitality room will be available for coaches, officials, media representatives with identification, and administrators. The hospitality room is not open or available for individual team members. In order to access the hospitality room, people **must have the official lanyard** passes given at check-in.

Team drop off

Bus/vans can drop off in front of the Ballenger Fieldhouse in "Loading Zone." A Mott Public Safety officer will escort your driver to the appropriate area to park and provide a ride back. Teams should be dropped off at the south entrance of Ballenger Field House.

Parking/ Registration

There is ample parking around campus. Feel free to park anywhere. See the campus map for options on page. Registration will be moved to the south entrance of the Ballenger Field House to avoid congestion.

Ticket Information

Any individual personnel not included on the official team roster **must purchase a ticket**.

These tickets must be purchased at the Ballenger Fieldhouse. Pricing is as follows:

Training Room and Medical Information

Two athletic trainers will be on site a minimum of 90 minutes prior to the tournament. The training room is located in the Ballenger Fieldhouse.

Locker room space will be provided for each team participating in the tournament. Each team is responsible for providing its own locks and towels. Secured locker rooms will be reserved for each team one hour prior to its game through one hour after the game.
